

## EasySoaker Boot Sizing

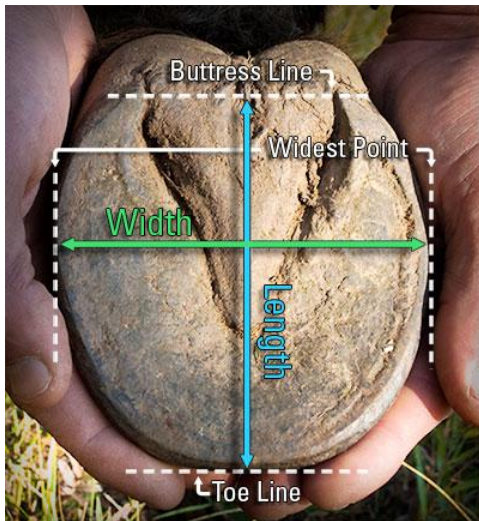
**Important: EasyCare recommends sizing up when purchasing an EasySoaker. Sizing up one to two sizes allows extra space for bandages and liquids to be used inside the boot. In addition, a larger size makes application and removal quicker and easier.**

XXX-Large	6 3/4" - 7 1/4"	7 1/4" - 7 3/4"	XXX-Large	172-184 mm	184-190 mm

Note: We recommend that a veterinarian diagnose any lameness or hoof problems.

How to get the correct size boot for your horse:

To determine the proper size boot for your horse, measure the width of the affected hoof, across the bottom at the widest point and from toe to heel. Choose from the recommended EasySoaker size charts below



We recommend that the horse be restrained or confined while you are soaking, as the boot is loose fitting and may come off if the horse moves around.
